# Winter Enrichments Have Been Posted - Sign-up Today!

Winter Enrichment offerings will run before school Monday through Thursday from November 30th through February 25th. <u>All enrichments are free of charge but parents/guardians MUST sign-up their student prior to a student attending a class</u>. Attendance will not be taken in enrichments but enrollment is still required so that we may plan for appropriate staffing, space, and supplies. Students may choose to attend an enrichment every day they are offered (Monday - Thursday) or just sign-up for a specific day or class.

### 1st Trimester Grades Available Through Parent Portal

To locate the 1st trimester grades, click on 'See All Apps' at the top of the page, and then 'Infinite Campus'. You will then be brought to Infinite Campus and can click on 'Grades' on the left column to see 1st trimester grades. Click <u>here</u> for an explanation of our grading system. If you have any questions about specific grades, please contact your student's teacher directly.

If you are having problems with Parent Portal please contact <u>Parent Portal support</u>. If you are unable to access the Parent Portal (after working with PP support) and wish to have grades mailed home, please complete this <u>Google form</u>. Please note – <u>mailing grades home is only offered as an exception</u>, and only for those unable to access Parent Portal.

### ICAP (Individual Career and Academic Plan)

All grade levels have had their first ICAP lessons of the year. This will be the

only lesson this year for 6th and 7th grader, however 8th graders will have an additional ICAP lesson focusing on High School Readiness in the spring.

ICAP is a part of a students <u>GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS</u>, and begins in 6th grade. Students must complete all ICAP lessons from 6th to12th grade to be eligible to graduate on time. If your student was absent during their ICAP lesson, they can use the slides and instructions found in their Grade Level Schoology Homeroom page to make up the lesson.
