

Student Code of Conduct

McAuliffe International School seeks to build a climate of mutual respect, trust, and courtesy where everyone is entitled to a secure and supportive learning environment. As such, we have instituted a Student Code of Conduct to set expectations for our students. For the full Student Code of Conduct, please see our Family Handbook on our website.

Student, please initial each line below indicating that you understand the expectations for you for the 2023-24 school year and that you agree to meet those expectations.

- I will not consume any drugs or alcohol, either at school or off campus and I will actively avoid situations where drugs or alcohol are present.
- I will not engage in any physical fighting
- I will seek out help from a trusted adult if I feel upset, sad, mad or scared and am worried about my personal safety in any way.
- I will not participate in any non-school sanctioned protests including walk-outs that jeopardize the safety of the students and staff at McAuliffe.
- I will not "ditch" classes and will only miss school when it is excused by my parent/guardian.
- I understand that if I engage in activities at school that are in violation of the Student Code of Conduct or if my behavior outside of school reflects poorly on McAuliffe or jeopardizes the safety of my classmates, I may not be able to participate in extracurricular activities, school trips, or athletics.
- I understand the opportunity to participate in these activities is a privilege and not a right.
- I understand that the principal of McAuliffe International School has full and final decision-making authority regarding my participation in extracurricular activities, school trips, or athletics based on the criteria outlined above.
